Surface Finish Maintenance

Antique Street Lamps recommends, at a minimum, annual maintenance be performed to prolong the finish life of your products. By following the maintenance procedures outline below, the high quality factory finish will be maintained longer against the long-term effects of weathering, their aesthetic features will be preserved and the photometric efficiency will be maintained.

Surface Cleaning

All luminaries should be cleaned annually in order to remove the dirt, dust and other containments that accumulate during the year to maintain surface appearance and photometric performance. Additionally, in climates where the products will be exposed to road salt, cleaning the spring is strongly recommended.

Surface Gloss Preservation

Gloss may be restored almost entirely utilizing paint finish restoration products similar to those used in the auto industry. Apply and remove per specific product recommendations.

Removal of Stickers or Adhesive Tape

Most commonly used stickers or adhesive tapes will not stick well to the lighting fixture's surface if they are removed promptly. Prompt removal will protect the finish and facilitate the cleaning process.

Removal of Graffiti

Graffiti is commonly applied with an acrylic or enamel based spray paint. It can easily be removed with most widely available paint removal products.
